

RE-OPENING PROTOCOLS & PROCEDURES

YOUR CHILD'S SAFETY IS OUR TOP PRIORITY!

- We are undergoing a complete sanitization of each studio, common areas and offices.
- We are currently clearing out the classrooms as there will be NO SHARING OF PROPS OF ANY KIND.
- The Academy will be following the CDC guidelines for cleaning and re-opening.
- 6 feet apart rule in all studios and common areas.
- The floor will be marked to show students /staff where to stand. When going across the floor, floor decals will show students where to stand while waiting their turn.
- Social distancing will be followed upon entering & exiting the main areas.
- Upon entry, all faculty, staff & students will be temperature-screened using a non-touch thermometer.
- Masks will be worn by Staff & Faculty at all times.
- 1 parent/guardian, wearing a mask, will drop off & pick up at the main door of the studio where class is being held.
- Students should wear masks at all times while at the Academy.
- Students cannot bring anything into the studio except their dance shoes and a water bottle which will remain in their personal 6 foot space. Only class attire should be worn when entering the Academy. Shoes worn outside will not be permitted on the classroom floor. Shoes can be changed & kept in a cubby during class.
- All faculty, staff & students will be required to sanitize their hands before and after class.
- Hand sanitizer is provided throughout the Academy.
- All restrooms will be wiped down after each use.
- Until further notice, please do not use the cubbies
- Common areas and classrooms will be sanitized between each class.
- Class times will be modified to accommodate the safe flow of students.
- No food or snacks will be provided for purchase.
- The Academy is closed to everyone other than faculty, staff & students.
- The Academy store, lobby and waiting areas are closed until further notice.

IMPORTANT NOTE!

- Please be aware that during this transition time, there will be no viewing of classes as we are trying to limit visitors in our common areas. We will be offering an alternate viewing option beginning in the Fall.

WHO SHOULD NOT COME TO CLASS AT THE ACADEMY?

- Any student not feeling well (fever, coughing, sneezing, etc)
- Any student that has been exposed to Covid-19.
- Any student living with a family member who has tested positive for Covid-19.
- Any student living with a family member who is ill.
- Anyone who has traveled to any of the states under quarantine
