We believe in teaching professionalism in the performing arts – from classroom etiquette through performance. Our production is a professional show, complete with lighting, sound crew, stage management, backstage supervisors and security. The students work very hard all season to prepare for their performance.

We highly encourage you to make this event special for them; maybe a small trip for ice cream afterwards! We have reserved an outdoor venue and plan to move forward with the performances at *Deerkill Day Camp* in Suffern, NY. The stage & seating area is completely covered and there is plenty of parking and space for social distancing. It's a great place and we couldn't be more excited to present our students' hard work and end of year presentation there!

Safety is our top priority for performers and their families. Our goal is to make each child's experience a positive and enjoyable one by not having much movement in the theatre. With this in mind, ALL students MUST remain with their class for the entirety of the performance. With this year's outdoor performance, updated guidelines will be handed out at dress rehearsal based on the venue.

Keep in mind, a copy of our event calendar can be found on our website and is updated regularly. In February, you will find a chart on the website listing your class information, including your mandatory dress rehearsal & photo session time.

We pride ourselves on the art of performance.

Students have this special weekend each season to showcase their hard work and dedication!

Educational

Throughout the year, students study all aspects of the performing arts.

Each class learns how to space and rehearse their routine.

The students are taught backstage procedures and stage etiquette.

Through the use of lighting and microphones, the technical side of a performance is introduced.

Professional

Students learn to dance, sing or act and turn it into a performance piece. While rehearsing in the classroom working on memorization and interacting with each other, respect for one another and teamwork is always reinforced. With pride and excitement, the students get on stage and entertain an audience. The performers are rewarded by the applause as bows are taken at curtain call as part of a full cast finale.

Dance routines and Musical Broadway scenes are choreographed and rehearsed with an expectation that ALL performers will be present for EVERY performance. If a student does not show up for one performance, it adversely affects the others in the class, which wouldn't be fair.

Also, as stated in this Recital Permission Agreement, students that do not attend Mandatory Dress Rehearsal will not be permitted to perform in the show as their absence will require us to re-space or re-assign their lines in a skit.

#1

STEP 1

READ the attached Recital Packet. It is imperative that you read the Agreement thoroughly and understand the expectations for your participation. You can access the packet by signing into your online Account and “view documents” located under “my account”

#2

STEP 2

COMPLETE the form in its entirety including signature.

This is your permission, agreement & show registration.

To *Opt Out*, check the *Opt Out* box and submit the form to the Academy office

STEP 3

SIGN & SUBMIT to the Academy Office No Later than **November 21, 2020** to avoid a late fee of \$25.00 per family.

FROM NOW THRU DECEMBER

Due to Covid restrictions, this year our parents will need to measure their child/children and submit the measurements on the attached Recital Permission Form. An instruction video can be found on our website. If measurements are not received, a costume cannot be ordered. We do take into consideration that students may grow from now until the end of the school year, and if a student is in the middle of a measurement, we do go up a size. NOVEMBER 21st

- **RECITAL PERMISSION FORMS AND COSTUME PAYMENT DUE. PLEASE BE SURE TO CHECK ALL SCHOOL EVENTS AND FAMILY OBLIGATIONS BEFORE SIGNING:**
 - By signing this agreement...
 - You are agreeing to ordering a costume for each class you are performing in
 - no refunds are given for costumes
 - size exchanges will be made upon Academy discretion
 - each costume will come with all accessories needed (headpieces, arm bands, etc.)
 - each costume will come with 1 pair of tights (if applicable)
 - You are agreeing to have the proper shoes for your class, as indicated on our website
 - You are agreeing to attend the Mandatory Dress Rehearsal(s). This information will be posted on the website sometime in February.
 - You are agreeing to participate in our Annual Showcase and follow procedures as listed below
 - You are responsible for knowing and adhering to your performance times & which show(s) you are in.
 - **Performances on Show Weekend:**
 - All classes will perform in 1 show on Recital Weekend
 - **Costume Costs Per Class:**

All performers will go home with their costume(s) in the spring. You will be given instructions that go along with your costume on how to sew the straps, how to wear the headpiece, etc. During the dress rehearsal, we will be sure everyone matches so they are ready to perform!

- *If seats remain available on show day, the cost is \$25.00 at the door*

APRIL 19th THRU APRIL 24th

- **COSTUME PHOTO WEEK with PHOTOGRAPHY BY SKY**

- *We are pleased to welcome back Kathryn Yannalfo from Sky Photography in Ramsey - <http://www.photographybysky.com> Individual costume photos are optional, however Photography by Sky will be here for the entire week during your child's regular class time.*
- *You will have the option to purchase a package of your choice.*
- *Most photo sessions will be during your regular class time; some may require an additional day. Your confirmed Photo Session time will be posted on the website in February.*
- *No other pictures are permitted on photo day. We appreciate your cooperation.*



JUNE 2ND THRU JUNE 4TH

MANDATORY DRESS REHEARSALS –

Wednesday thru Friday, June 2 – June 4, 2021 at Deerkill Day Camp, 45 Wilder Rd., Suffern, NY

- Each class in the show will have a 15 minute stage dress rehearsal.
- During the 15 minute time slot:
 - we will make sure all the performers' costumes match, are sewn properly, headpiece is worn correctly, etc.
 - the class will space their dance for the stage
 - the class will run their dance with the music
- After your child rehearses, you can pick up your ordered items & show wristbands at the check-in table

All performers must attend the Mandatory Dress Rehearsal scheduled for their classes June 2 – June 4, 2021 during their scheduled time which will be posted on the website in February.

ANY STUDENT THAT MISSES DRESS REHEARSAL WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SHOW.

If a performer is sick that day, they should try to come for the 15 minutes.

If your child is too sick to attend, it is imperative that you contact the studio that morning, and a doctor's note will be required to allow participation in the show.

Infinite Motion Procedures for Dress Rehearsal

- Only 1 parent per student is permitted at dress rehearsal.
- Students should arrive in costume, but please change into your dance shoes upon arrival.
- If you have multiple costumes, a dressing area will be available for you to change.
- You may take pictures or video during the dress rehearsal, but please stay behind the staff area.
- Please arrive a few minutes early and sit with your class because we run ON TIME and cannot wait for you!

Infinite Motion Procedures for our Annual Spring Showcase

- Doors open ½ hour before each show and each performance will run approximately 1 hour without an intermission.
- All performers are required to remain with their class for the entirety of the performance.
- No parents, siblings, or relatives will be permitted backstage during the performance.
- Students/performers will be permitted backstage only if a costume change is required.
- One guardian is permitted to drop off their child in the backstage area 30 minutes prior to show time. The same guardian will be required to pick up their child once security has opened the backstage area for pick up.
- Please note that only IMPAA faculty and crew will be allowed backstage during show time for the safety of all.
- We ask that all students are present in class the entire month prior to the show; absences affect the performance.
- **GRADUATING SENIORS:** please stop in the office so we can discuss your senior spotlight.
- **MUSICAL BROADWAY STUDENTS** may be required to attend a tech rehearsal/sound check prior to show time. Exact details will be handed out at Dress Rehearsal.

I understand that by signing at the bottom of this page, I have read the ENTIRE show agreement and I agree to the following statements:

- My child must attend the Mandatory Dress Rehearsal(s) during their scheduled time(s) June 2 – 4, 2021.
- I understand that if my child misses dress rehearsal, they will not be permitted to participate in the show.
- My child must remain with their class for the entirety of the performance.
- I must obtain my child’s scheduled times for Dress Rehearsal, Picture Day and Show Weekend when they are posted on the website in February.
- I understand that I will be able to walk my child to the backstage area 30 minutes prior to show time, and I will be permitted to pick up my child once security has opened the backstage area for pick up after the show. I understand that signatures must match when dropping off and picking up my child. I understand that only IMPAA faculty, security & crew will be allowed backstage during show time for the safety of all performers.
- I understand there are no refunds for costumes; size exchanges will be made upon Academy discretion.
- I understand that if I turn this form in later than November 21, 2020, I will be charged a \$25.00 late fee & there is no guarantee my child’s costume will be here in time for Photo Week in April.
- I understand that any lost costumes or costume accessory will result in a \$10.00 fee to cover shipping & handling in addition to the actual cost of the missing piece.
- I understand that failure to follow through on this agreement will result in my child’s dismissal from Academy performance(s).
